A JOURNEY WITH DOMINIC MARRONE

WHO IS DOMINIC MARRONE?

DOB:
15th May 1934

BIRTH PLACE:
Altavilla Irpina, Province Avellino, Italy

HISTORY: Dominic Marrone came from a large family of eight. His mother, Giuseppina and father Antonio had six children, Raffaele, Giuseppina, Dominic, Angelina, Carmine and Armando. He was part of a family of two girls and four boys. As a youngster Dominic Marrone worked in his father's farm which included growing of crops including wheat, beans, corn, hazel nuts, cucumbers, tomatoes and grapes for wine making.

Life was difficult in Altavilla Irpina, employment was scarce and Dominic was looking for better working opportunities. In 1952 after of learning employment opportunities in a new land he immigrated to Australia.

At age 18 in Australia, Dominic Marrone began his first Australian job at James Brickworks factory at Toogood Ave Beverley. This was Dominic's hardest job, cutting clay bricks for eight hours a day ready for firing in the Beverly brick kilns. At that time he was paid eight pounds a week. After 9 months he was fortunate to obtain a better job close by at General Motors Holden (GMH) Woodville, in the metal finishing department. As an ambitious young man Dominic tried his hands in other industries such as a factory hand at Simpson and Pope and grape picking in Mildura. In 1956 he purchased a taxi with Green Cabs but he could not get a licence until he did a language and location test, so did a lawn mowing round for a month whilst learning the roads of Adelaide. He passed his test for a taxi licence at the Unley Council. He continued driving a taxi for four years.

Through hard work he was able to purchase twenty acres of land at Virginia with his brother in law. Given his farming and gardening background Dominic was able to produce various crops including all type of vegetables ie tomatoes, onion, carrots, potatoes, corn which he sold to market garden wholesalers.

Dominic Marrone married the love of his life, Linda, at Saint Francis of Assisi Church Campbelltown in 1957. They had 3 children, Frank, Rita and Robert. Dominic lived in Virginia for approximately 24 years. Dominic later purchased a property at Rostrevor where he has been living ever since.

Since the early immigration in the 1950's families from Altavilla Irpina have always had a special devotion to their patron saint - San Pellegrino Martire. In 1976, a group of Altavillese formed the San Pellegrino Martire Festa Committee led by Enrico Grande as the first President. On the 29th January 1978 saw the first San Pellegrino Martire festa. During this time the San Pellegrino Committee elected Bernardino Tirri to take the reign of Presidency.

During 1979 Bernardino Tirri asked Dominic Marrone to assist the committee with raising funds for the festa. Given Dominic had the taxi he was allocated the Salisbury, Elizabeth, Gawler area for door knocking and asking for donations. Other committee members were responsible for other zones. Funding and organising the festas were no small feat. Over the years it was estimated 15,000 to 20,000 people participated in the celebrations over two days and funds were scarce. But due to a large dedicated San Pellegrino Martire Festa Committee the festas were very well organized and were very successful at St Ignatius church and grounds at Norwood.

In 1990 Dominic Marrone was elected President of the Altavilla Sports and Social Club and continued to support the San Pellegrino Martire Festa Committee. After a number of years in 2003 he was re-elected President of the Altavilla Sports and Social Club this time for two years.

During 1994 Dominic and Linda were able to return to Italy on a much deserved holiday. He retired as President in 2005, but continued to be involved with the Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social club and the San Pellegrino Martire Festa Committee.

In 2001 the festa was temporarily suspended due to the non availability of the Saint Ignatius Junior School grounds and building works. Also contributing to the suspension was the aging of the San Pellegrino Martire Festa Committee, their physical ability and time to visit the homes of the Paesani to raise donations, contributions were only collected at the religious ceremony thereon. It was agreed upon in 2015 due to the said age constraints of committee members and illnesses, it was decided to consolidate and amalgamate the committee with Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social Club. The amalgamation was largely thanks to negotiations of the President of the San Pellegrino Martire Festa Committee, Benardino Tirri, Altavilla Sports and Social Club, President Peter Varricchio, Dominic Marrone, Hon Greg Crafter and both associations committees.

Dominic Marrone had a special spiritual devotion to St Pellegrino Martire. Since 1979 Dominic has represented the then San Pellegrino Martire Festa Committee and since 2015 the Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social Club carrying the San Pellegrino banner at all South Australian religious festas. A true symbol of faith to the saint.

UN VIAGGIO CON DOMINIC MARRONE

CHI È DOMINIC MARRONE?

DATA DI NASCITA: 15 maggio 1934

Altavilla Irpina, Provincia di Avellino, Italia

STORIA: Dominic Marrone proviene da una famiglia numerosa di otto persone. Sua madre, Giuseppina e suo padre Antonio, avevano sei figli: Raffaele, Giuseppina, Dominic, Angelina, Carmine e Armando; quattro ragazzi e due ragazze. Da giovane, Dominic Marrone lavorava nella fattoria di suo padre coltivando grano, fagioli, mais, nocciole, cetrioli, pomodori e uva per fare il vino.

La vita era difficile ad Altavilla Irpina: il lavoro scarseggiava e Dominic cercava un futuro migliore. Nel 1952, dopo aver scoperto che c'erano opportunità di lavoro, è emigrato in Australia.

All'età di 18 anni, Dominic Marrone ha iniziato il suo primo lavoro australiano presso la fabbrica James Brickworks a Toogood Ave, Beverley. Questo è stato il lavoro più difficile per Dominic; doveva tagliare mattoni di argilla per otto ore al giorno, così che fossero pronti per la cottura nelle fornaci di Beverley. A quel tempo, veniva pagato otto sterline a settimana. Dopo 9 mesi, ha avuto la fortuna di ottenere un lavoro migliore nelle vicinanze, presso la General Motors Holden (GMH), a Woodville, nel reparto di finitura dei metalli.

Da giovane ambizioso, Dominic si è cimentato in altri settori come operaio a Simpson e Pope e come bracciante nella raccolta dell'uva a Mildura. Nel 1956, ha acquistato un taxi con Green Cabs, ma non è riuscito a ottenerne la licenza fino a quando non ha sostenuto un test di lingua e orientamento. Ha tagliato prati per un mese, mentre imparava le strade di Adelaide, poi ha superato l'esame per la licenza di taxi al comune di Unley. Ha continuato a guidare taxi per quattro anni.

Lavorando duramente, è riuscito ad acquistare venti acri di terreno a Virginia, con suo cognato. Dato il suo background agricolo e di giardinaggio, Dominic è riuscito a produrre vari raccolti tra cui: pomodori, cipolle, carote, patate e mais che ha venduto ai grossisti.

Dominic Marrone ha sposato l'amore della sua vita, Linda, nella chiesa di San Francesco d'Assisi a Campbelltown, nel 1957. Hanno avuto 3 figli, Frank, Rita e Robert. Dominic ha vissuto in Virginia per circa 24 anni. In seguito, ha acquistato una proprietà a Rostrevor, dove vive da allora.

Fin dalla prima immigrazione, negli anni '50, le famiglie di Altavilla Irpina hanno avuto una forte devozione per il loro santo patrono, San Pellegrino Martire. Nel 1976, un gruppo di altavillesi costituì il Comitato della Festa di San Pellegrino Martire guidato da Enrico Grande come primo Presidente.

Il 29 gennaio 1978, ci fu la prima festa di San Pellegrino Martire. In quel periodo, il Comitato di San Pellegrino elesse Bernardino Tirri a presidente.

Nel 1979, Bernardino Tirri chiese a Dominic Marrone di assistere il comitato nella raccolta fondi per la festa, dato che Dominic aveva il taxi che gli era stato assegnato per l'area di Salisbury, Elizabeth e Gawler per andare di casa in casa a chiedere donazioni. Altri membri del comitato erano responsabili di altre zone.

Finanziare e organizzare le feste non era cosa da poco. Si stima che nel corso degli anni da 15.000 a 20.000 persone abbiano partecipato alle celebrazioni nell'arco di due giorni e i fondi erano scarsi. Ma grazie a un grande comitato dedicato alla festa di San Pellegrino, le feste sono state organizzate molto bene e hanno avuto molto successo nella chiesa di Sant'Ignazio e sui terreni di Norwood.

Nel 1990, Dominic Marrone è stato eletto Presidente dell'Altavilla Sports and Social Club e ha continuato a sostenere il Comitato della Festa di San Pellegrino. Dopo alcuni anni, nel 2003, è stato rieletto Presidente dell'Altavilla Sports and Social Club, questa volta per due anni.

Nel 1994, Dominic e Linda sono tornati in Italia per una meritata vacanza. Dominic si è ritirato dalla carica di presidente nel 2005, ma ha continuato a collaborare con l'Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social club e con il Comitato di San Pellegrino Martire.

Nel 2001, la festa è stata temporaneamente sospesa a causa dell'indisponibilità del terreno della scuola di Sant'Ignazio e di lavori di costruzione. Hanno contribuito alla sospensione anche l'invecchiamento dei membri del Comitato di San Pellegrino che non potevano o non avevano il tempo di visitare le case dei paesani per raccogliere donazioni. Le offerte erano raccolte solo durante la cerimonia religiosa.

Nel 2015, a causa dei suddetti vincoli di età dei membri del comitato e, in alcuni casi, di malattie, si è deciso di consolidare e fondere il comitato con l'Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social Club. La fusione è stata raggiunta soprattutto grazie alle trattative del Presidente del Comitato di San Pellegrino, Bernardino Tirri, dell'Altavilla Sports and Social Club, del Presidente Peter Varricchio, di Dominic Marrone, dell'On. Greg Crafter e di entrambi i comitati delle associazioni.

Dominic Marrone ha una devozione spirituale speciale per San Pellegrino Martire. Dal 1979, Dominic ha rappresentato l'allora Comitato di San Pellegrino Martire e dal 2015 l'Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social Club portando lo stendardo di San Pellegrino a tutte le feste religiose dell'Australia Meridionale. Un vero simbolo di fede per il santo.

AUSTRALIA'S FIRST SAINT - ST MARY OF THE CROSS CELEBRATING ST MARY HELEN MACKILLOP 180 YEARS (1842 – 2022)

"BE A GIFT OF LOVE AND COMPASSION FOR ONE ANOTHER"



The San Pellegrino Community of the Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social Club was proud to sponsor a bronze statue dedicated to Saint, Mary MacKillop – St. Mary of the Cross. The bronze statue, by renowned local artist Judith Rolevink, was

unveiled and blessed by Archbishop Patrick O'Regan on October 17th 2020 to coincide with the 10th anniversary of the canonisation of St Mary of the Cross at St Francis Xaviers Cathedral.

This year's 2022 San Pellegrino festa co-insides with 180 years of the birth of St Mary MacKillop.

The following is a brief history of the life of St Mary MacKillop's life:-

- St Mary MacKillop founded the Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart. The order now has more than 850 members, who run schools, aged care homes and undertake community work in Australia, New Zealand, East Timor, Ireland, Scotland, Peru and Brazil.
- St Mary MacKillop was born in Melbourne on 15th January 1842. She started work as a governess in the South Australian country town of Penola in 1861.
- St Mary MacKillop and English Priest Julian Tenison Woods opened their first school at Penola in 1866. A year later, she opened her first convent and school in Adelaide, and she took her religious vows in August 1867. Within five years, 40 schools, convents and four charitable institutions were founded.

- St Mary MacKillop regularly clashed with the male-dominated Church hierarchy over her wish to retain central control of her order. The ongoing tensions led to St Mary MacKillop being excommunicated from the Catholic Church in 1871. The excommunication order was removed five months later.
- St Mary MacKillop died in Sydney on August 8, 1909. She was buried at a local cemetery, but her remains were moved to a new memorial chapel in North Sydney in 1914.
- The first moves to have St Mary MacKillop canonized began in 1926. In 1973, the Vatican allowed St Mary MacKillop to have the title Servant of God, which gave formal approval to develop a case for sainthood. She was beatified in 1995 at a ceremony in Sydney during a visit to Australia by Pope John Paul II.
- In 2009 Pope Benedict XVI approved a second miracle attributed to St Mary MacKillop, which was the final step needed before she could be declared a saint.
- St Mary MacKillop was Canonised (made a saint) on 17th October, 2010.
- In 1995 the Mary MacKillop Museum was opened at 19 Phillips Street, Kensington.
- In 2020 the Mary MacKillop Walking Trail was created. Come"walk on the land where Mary MacKillop walked...breath in her spirit... pray where she prayed so often..."

LA PRIMA SANTA AUSTRALIANA - SANTA MARIA DELLA CROCE - CELEBRAZIONE DI SANTA MARIA HELEN MACKILLOP 180 ANNI (1842 – 2022)

"Siate un dono di amore e compassione gli uni per gli altri"



La Comunità San Pellegrino dell'Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social Club ha sponsorizzato con orgoglio una statua in bronzo dedicata a Santa Mary MacKillop – Santa Maria della Croce. La statua in bronzo, opera della famosa artista locale

Judith Rolevink, è stata inaugurata e benedetta dall'arcivescovo Patrick O'Regan il 17 ottobre 2020 in concomitanza con il decimo anniversario della canonizzazione di Santa Maria della Croce nella cattedrale di St Francis Xaviers.

La festa di San Pellegrino del 2022 coincide con il 180esimo anniversario dalla nascita di St Mary MacKillop.

Quella che segue è una breve storia della vita di St Mary MacKillop:

- St Mary MacKillop fondò la congregazione religiosa delle Suore di San Giuseppe del Sacro Cuore. L'ordine conta ora più di 850 membri, che gestiscono scuole, case di cura per anziani e svolgono attività comunitarie in Australia, Nuova Zelanda, Timor Est, Irlanda, Scozia, Perù e Brasile.
- St Mary MacKillop nacque a Melbourne il 15 gennaio 1842. Iniziò a lavorare come governante nella cittadina di Penola, nell'Australia Meridionale, nel 1861.
- St Mary MacKillop e il sacerdote inglese Julian Tenison Woods aprirono la loro prima scuola a Penola, nel 1866. Un anno dopo, Mary aprì il suo primo convento e scuola ad Adelaide, e prese i voti religiosi nell'agosto 1867. In cinque anni vennero fondate: 40 scuole, conventi e quattro istituzioni caritative.

• St Mary MacKillop si scontrò regolarmente con la gerarchia della Chiesa dominata dagli uomini per il suo desiderio di mantenere il controllo centrale del suo ordine. Le tensioni in corso portarono alla scomunica di Santa Mary MacKillop dalla Chiesa cattolica nel 1871. L'ordine di scomunica fu rimosso cinque mesi dopo.

• St Mary MacKillop morì a Sydney l'8 agosto 1909. Fu sepolta in un cimitero locale, ma i suoi resti vennero trasferiti in una nuova cappella commemorativa a North Sydney nel 1914.

• I primi tentativi per canonizzare Santa Mary MacKillop furono nel 1926. Nel 1973, il Vaticano concesse a Santa Mary MacKillop il titolo di Serva di Dio, che diede l'approvazione formale per presentare un caso per la santità. Santa Mary MacKillop fu beatificata nel 1995 con una cerimonia a Sydney durante una visita in Australia di Papa Giovanni Paolo II.

• Nel 2009, Papa Benedetto XVI ha approvato un secondo miracolo attribuito a Santa Mary MacKillop, che era l'ultimo passo prima che potesse essere dichiarata santa.

• St Mary MacKillop è stata canonizzata (fatta santa) il 17 ottobre 2010.

• Nel 1995 è stato aperto il Mary MacKillop Museum, al numero 19 di Phillips Street, Kensington.

• Nel 2020, è stato creato il percorso a piedi Mary MacKillop. "Vieni...cammina sulla terra dove camminò Mary MacKillop... respira nel suo spirito... prega dove lei pregò così spesso..."

Fr Michael Romeo is a priest of the Archdiocese of Adelaide. He was born in Adelaide in 1983 attending school at St Joseph's Primary, Hectorville and Rostrevor College,

Woodforde. He pursued tertiary studies at Adelaide University from 2002-2006, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts (History), Diploma in Languages and a Graduate Diploma of Education. He studied for the Priesthood at Corpus Christi Seminary in Melbourne and was ordained on 29 August 2014. From 2014 until 2017, he served as assistant priest in the parishes of Mount Gambier and Millicent. In January 2018, he was appointed the Parish Priest of Penola where he currently resides looking after the towns of Penola, Kingston SE, Robe and Kalangadoo.

MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL ROMEO

Dear friends,

Very often I hear comments about the future of feasts like that of San Pellegrino Martire such as, the need to 'maintain the festa' and 'uphold our traditions for the future' or 'get the next generations involved.' While we wish to see that the feasts continue into the future, we should ask ourselves, "what is it exactly we wish to 'maintain' or 'uphold'?" It is wonderful to see so many families participate in the evening festivities and enjoying the ability to meet with friends while appreciating delicious food and good entertainment. But let's face it, what is at the heart of the feast – the saint or the zeppole? There is no festa without the saint. We must be careful not to lose sight of the religious foundation which underpins feasts like that of San Pellegrino Martire.

The simple fact of the matter is that if an unknown Christian pilgrim whom we know as Pellegrino decided to stay home instead of travelling to Rome, then he would not have been killed for being a Christian, he would not have been buried in the catacombs, his bodily remains would not have been discovered and brought to Altavilla Irpina – there would be no festa there on 25 August and certainly no festa here in Adelaide.




